### Qualifications and Guidelines to be added to this list:

1. A Walk person should submit a group photo to Secretariat for consideration.
2. Know where and when the photographer must arrive to set up for the picture-taking.
3. Knows the aspect ratio of the camera and what dimensions it captures for the picture and what will be cut out when transferring the picture to an 8”X10” size.
4. When taking a picture of a large group (e.g., 50-125),
  - Knows how to use additional lighting when in a dark location
  - Knows how to arrange the people so
    - Everyone can be seen in the picture because there will be multiple rows (important to know how the depth of the group will look in the final picture – the rows closest to the photographer should be shorter with rows further back being wider).
    - Each face is visible (i.e., if they can’t see the camera, the camera can’t see them).
5. Ensures chas have established boundaries markers (e.g., tape or ropes) to ensure everyone is seated within those boundaries so they will appear in the group picture.

6. Can be good at entertaining and helping chas and song team to a light-hearted time to keep the candidates distracted while the background team members enter the rows behind the candidates and are seated, so candidates don't look back to see what's happening.
7. Knows what to do to redirect background team positioning without revealing their presence behind the candidates.
8. Knows how to use photo editing capabilities to download, edit and save the best color picture that shows everyone's face clearly and the best black & white picture that shows everyone holding a numbered card and ensures those picture files are
  - Delivered to and order placed at a local store that can print out the correct number of color copies and the correct number of black and white copies (number specified by the Recorder)
  - Ensuring all copies of the color and black & white pictures are paid for (using funds provided by the Head Cha) are picked up
  - Ensuring that the copies of color and black & white pictures are given to the Recorder for inclusion in the Fourth Day Packets no later than Sunday morning.
